Vancouver Master Chorale COVID-19 Terms and Conditions

Vancouver Master Chorale (VMC) is committed to the safety of all VMC concert attendees, including guests, performers, volunteers and staff. The following safety protocols will be enforced to ensure a safe environment at performances and rehearsals. These terms and conditions may be modified if needed based on new information from the CDC or state of Washington; please revisit these Terms and Conditions prior to concerts for any modifications.

Safety Requirements

- All performers, including singers, director and instrumentalists must be fully vaccinated* against COVID-19, and provide proof of vaccination prior to participating in any rehearsals or performances. In addition, masks** are required of all members.
- All concert guests will be fully vaccinated* against COVID-19, and provide proof of vaccination and photo ID to VMC staff to be admitted to in-person performances. In addition, masks** are required of concert guests. Children will also follow this vaccination protocol; if they do not have photo ID, they will be accompanied by an adult who is fully vaccinated* against COVID-19 and provides photo ID.
- VMC volunteers and staff must be fully vaccinated* against COVID-19, and provide proof of vaccination prior to participating in any concert or rehearsal activities. In addition, masks** are required of all volunteers and staff.
- Unvaccinated children will not be able to attend any in-person performances until further notice.

*Full vaccination (having received the second dose of either the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine or the Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine, or the one dose of the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 Vaccine) must be complete at least 14 days prior to performance.

**Mask requirement will follow the regulations of the CDC and state of Washington.

Cancellation Policy

If any performance is cancelled, ticket-holders will have the following options: 1) Receive full reimbursement; or 2) Donate their payment to Vancouver Master Chorale.

Intermission

There will be a short intermission during the concert. Concert guests are encouraged to take necessary restroom breaks during the performance.

Risk

Vancouver Master Chorale will adhere to the above COVID protocol in order to protect guests as much as possible. Everybody attending performances or rehearsals agrees to comply with this protocol. They also understand that COVID-19 is highly contagious, and agree to assume any risk of exposure to COVID-19 while attending these gatherings.
